Prior to completing this please make note that the government expects pupils who are:

- [Clinically extremely vulnerable](#) – to stay at home
- [Clinically vulnerable](#) – for parents to follow medical guidance

- Living with someone that's clinically extremely vulnerable – to stay at home, unless stringent social distancing can be adhered to, and the pupil in question can understand and follow those instructions
- Living with someone that's clinically vulnerable (e.g. pregnant) – to come to school

**Pupils must not come to school if they or anyone in their household has coronavirus symptoms, if this occurs once they have started school then please notify the school immediately.**

Should a child display any COVID-19 symptoms during the day, we will isolate them and need them to return home as soon as possible. Please ensure that a parent is contactable and available to collect your child should they display symptoms. Please also ensure that the contact details the school has for you are correct. To do this, please go onto the SIMS parent app and check your contact details are correct. If you have any issues or concerns on the day and need to contact the school we will be operating a normal reception service between 9am and 1.30pm, this will be by telephone **ONLY** to keep the number of people on the school grounds to a minimum.
