Dear Parent/Carer and pupil,

RE: Theatre Trip – An Inspector Calls by J.B.Priestley – Wednesday 11th September, 7.30pm at the Churchill Theatre, Bromley

The English Department is delighted to offer Year 10 classes the fantastic opportunity to see the live production of the play *An Inspector Calls* by J.B. Priestley at The Churchill Theatre, Bromley on Wednesday 11th September 2019.

The play is one of the texts they will study for their GCSE English Literature course in Year 11. It is therefore important for students to consider the play as a performance and seeing it in production in the theatre is an experience that cannot be underestimated. This is the ideal way to bring the text to life as well as develop and enhance their understanding of the play and its context.

The itinerary for the trip is as follows: Students will need to arrive at Warlingham school by 6pm at the latest on Wednesday 11th September and will travel by coach to the theatre in Bromley. The production is 1 hour 45 minutes long. Students will return by coach to Warlingham School at approximately 10pm, depending on traffic.

We have 94 places available and therefore places will be dealt with on a first come, first served basis, however attendance on the trip will depend on student’s behaviour in school. The total cost of the trip including travel and theatre tickets will be £27.00. In order to secure your son/daughter’s place on the trip payment must be paid by Wisepay. The Wisepay account for this trip will open on Friday 14th June at 8.30am. If you require financial assistance for this trip please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Christie as soon as possible, each individual case will need to be assessed at the earliest opportunity.
