Dear Parents/Carers

RE: Important update regarding Year 6 into 7 induction.

It is with regret that I am writing to inform you, that despite efforts to mitigate against and comply with COVID-19 restrictions we will not be able to meet with either students or parents on the 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> June as we had previously intended.

We understand and share the disappointment that this will cause the students, however we have adapted our plans, so that much of the opportunities and experiences that the students would have enjoyed this June, will be rescheduled for their start in September. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> September, only year 7 and year 12 students will be in school, so that these years groups can maximise the opportunities for their induction.

We are hopeful that we will be able to arrange a parents/carers meeting early in the Autumn term, providing a face-to-face opportunity to meet with both the tutors and the Headteacher. In the meantime, we are planning a virtual forum, whereby parents and carers can put forward questions in advance. This forum is scheduled for 6pm on the 14<sup>th</sup> July, further details of how to participate will follow shortly.

Please familiarise yourselves with the details currently provided by the Schools website, here you will find the school handbook, alongside other useful information for both you and your child. In the absence of a face to face meeting this term, we will shortly be uploading a message to each of the students from their tutors. We hope that this will provide answers to most of the questions you and your child will undoubtedly have, until we meet the Students, Parents and Carers in the Autumn.
