The login details you enter must match those we have on record for you.

Appointments will be available to book from **8.00pm TODAY, Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2024** until **11.00pm Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2024**.

Please note that there is only one appointment available per class and student. It is not possible for parents/carers to book consecutive appointments to allow time for parents to move from one class to another. Appointments will be available for parents/carers of students who receive SEN support to see Mrs Hunt if required.

The classrooms allocated for Parents Evening will be in B and A Block. On arrival to the school, ***please sign in at the B Block entrance in B10*** and collect a map to help you find your allotted appointments. The PTA would like to offer refreshments in B10 on the evening; however, they are struggling to find volunteers to help.
