Art Exhibition 2026

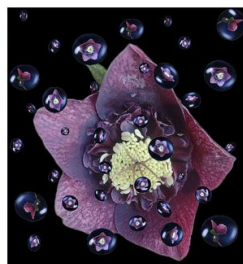
Warlingham School is delighted to invite parents, carers, friends and relatives to our Art Exhibition 2026.
