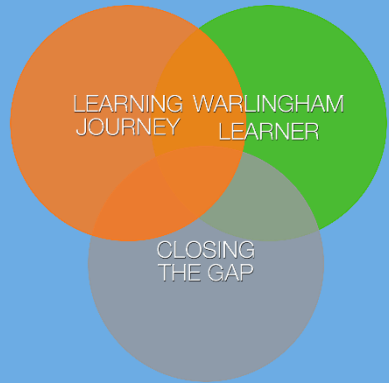

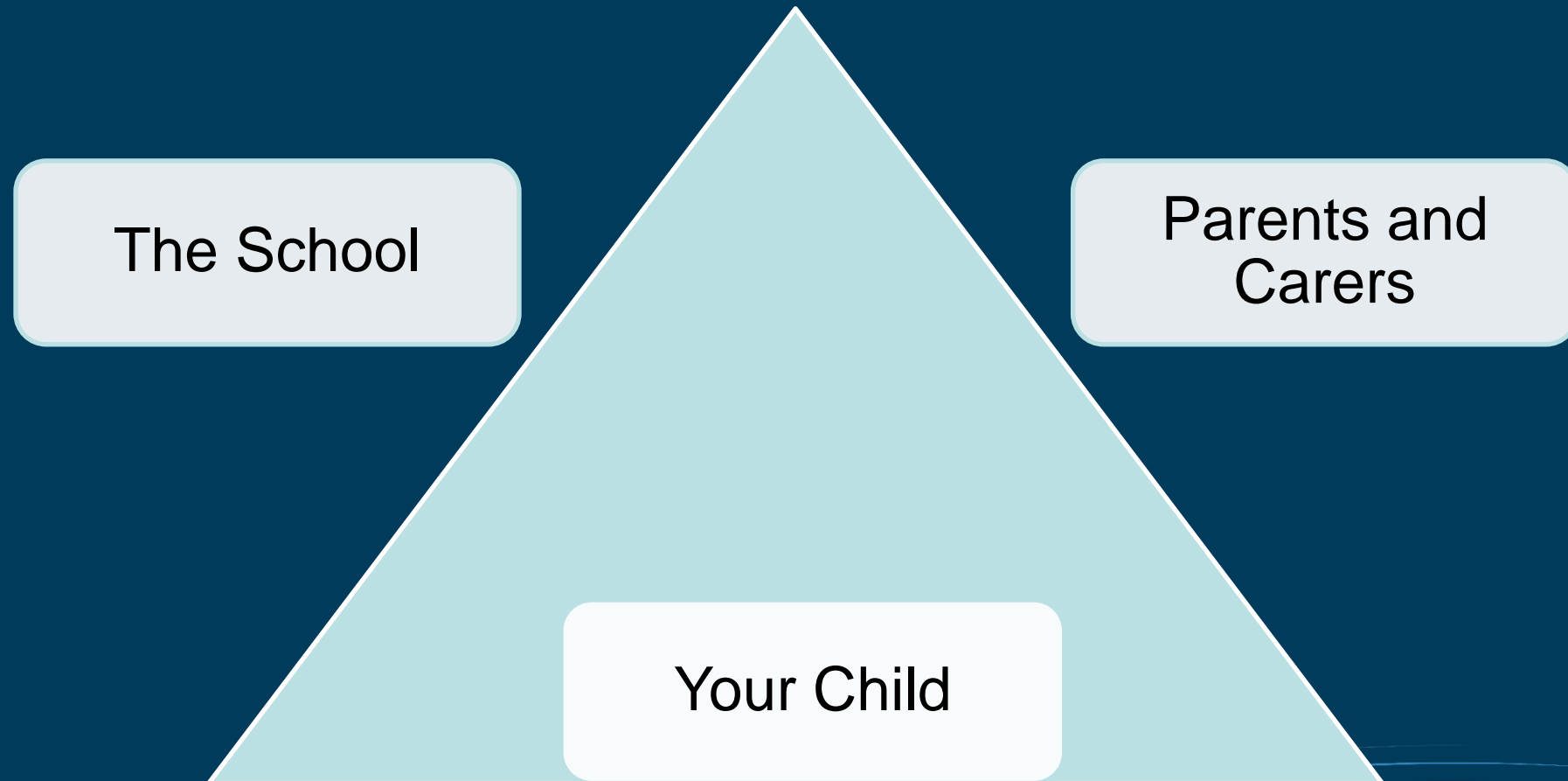

We believe that Warlingham School should be a space that is built on systemic kindness and is actively anti-discriminatory.

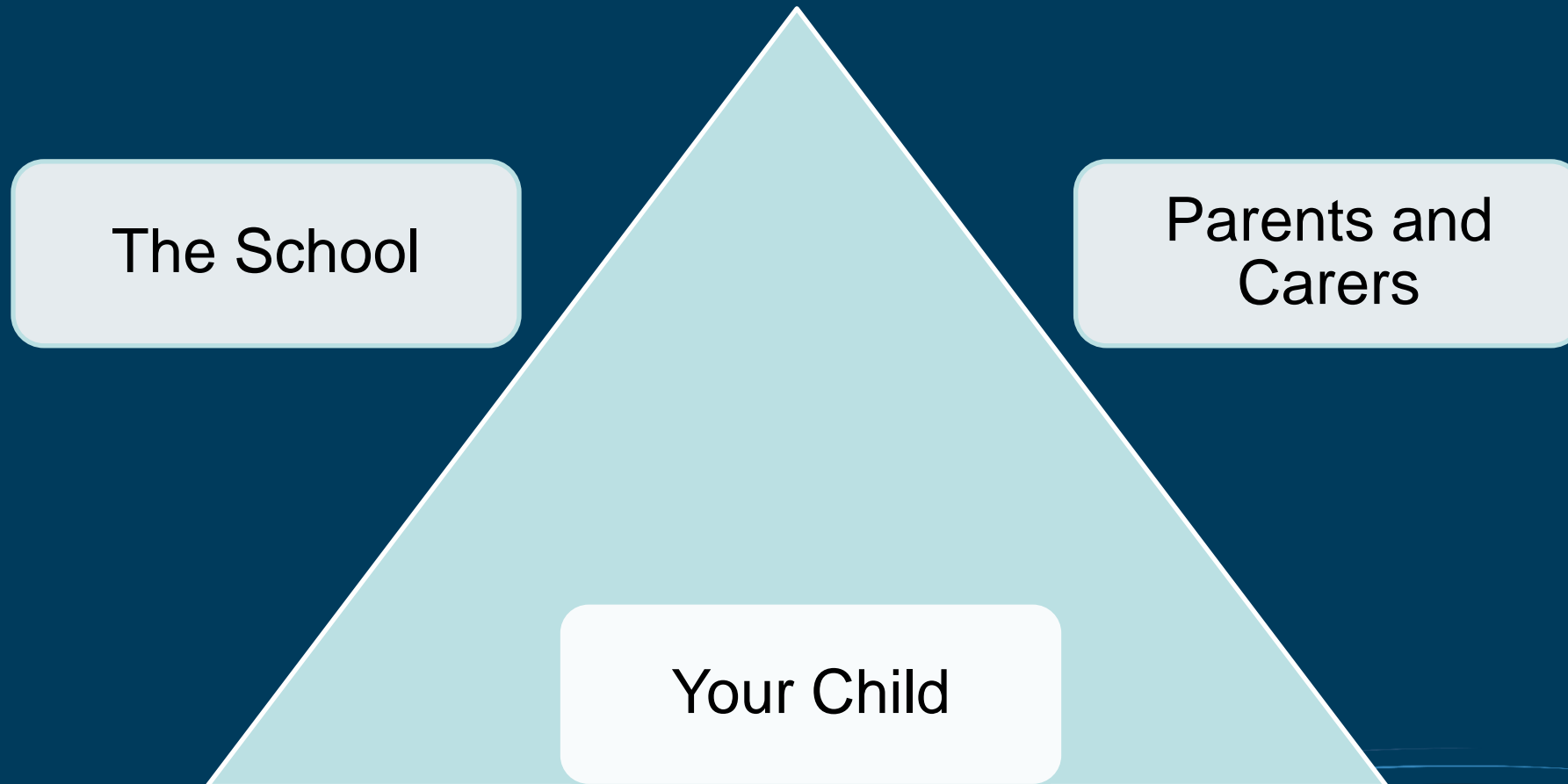
