Three of the students stayed with the child to ensure they were safe and reassured, while the other two returned quickly to school to alert a member of the leadership team. Thanks to their swift and thoughtful actions, the child was safely and promptly reunited with their parent/carer.

Kara, Libby, Ruby, Isla, and Selena demonstrated exceptional maturity, compassion, and initiative. We are incredibly proud of them for responding so responsibly and caringly in what could have been a very distressing situation. Their actions helped ensure the child's safety and brought great reassurance to their family.
