We are delighted to invite you to our **Meet the Tutor Evening for Years 11–13** on **Wednesday 17th September, 5pm – 6pm in the main hall**. This is an important event in the school calendar and a valuable opportunity for us to work together in supporting your child through the year ahead.

The evening will begin with a central presentation exploring how all Year 11, 12 and 13 students can prepare effectively for this academic year — looking at revision strategies, managing anxiety, access arrangements for exams and non-examined assessments (NEA).
