Lockdown Drill

Please be aware that the school will be conducting a lockdown drill next week. This is a test and forms part of our regular safety procedures. The drill will last for a few minutes and students will be fully briefed in advance to ease any concerns, particularly for our more vulnerable students. We thank you for support with this practice.

Student Leadership

Last week, we were delighted to welcome 5 members of the student leadership group to present at the weekly senior leadership meeting. They put together a wonderful presentation explaining who they were and what they wanted to achieve, how the group has evolved and what their hopes are for the future. There were several areas identified for discussion and I am pleased to share that following feedback from the student leadership group, we have implemented a change to the toilets available for students in B block. 3 of the toilets will now be specifically for boys and 3 specifically for girls with new signage. Gender-neutral and accessible toilets are available on the ground and first floor. This change has been shared with students, along with asking all students to respect these communal areas by keeping the areas clean, being mindful of noise and disruption to nearby classrooms and with the encouragement for students to use the toilets at an appropriate time during the day to avoid the use of them being an excuse for being late to lessons.

We look forward to hearing more about their plans to support and improve the school in the coming months.

Resources to support young people

This week, we wanted to share some important resources and insights to help support young people.

- We have provided access to three helpful guides:
 - Navigating Depression and Low Mood: A Practical Guide for Young People
 - Social Anxiety: A Factsheet for Young People
 - An Online Safety Guide

These resources offer practical activities and advice to help young people manage their mental well-being and navigate the online world safely. Additionally, we'd like to raise awareness of some commonly used emojis and their meanings, as they can sometimes reflect hidden online trends, including those linked to toxic or harmful ideologies. A brief overview:

- **Red Pill** Often linked to misogynistic ideologies
- Dynamite A symbol of radicalisation in certain online spaces
- Black Hole Represents feelings of depression or hopelessness
- 100 Emoji Associated with the idea that 80% of women are only attracted to 20% of men
- Frog Emoji Sometimes linked to extremist online culture

There are also different meanings behind heart emojis:

♥ Love | ♥ Lust | ♥ Interest | ♥ Interest without sex | ♥ Support
