To login you will need to enter:

- Your child's first name, surname and date of birth

The login details you enter must match those we have on record for you.

Appointments will be available to book from **8.00pm TODAY, Wednesday 21st January 2026** until **11.00pm Wednesday 28th January 2026**.

Please note that there is only one appointment available per class and student. It is not possible for parents/carers to book consecutive appointments to allow time for parents to move from one class to another.

Unfortunately, the DT teacher of 9X1, 9X4, 9Y1 and 9Y4 will not be available to attend the Year 9 Parents' Evening. As they are new to the school and have only taught the classes for one or two lessons, they would be unable to provide a sufficiently informed overview of your child's progress at this time.

However, the Heads of Department would be very happy to meet with parents and carers to discuss Design and Technology at the Year 9 Options Evening on Wednesday 11th February. Alternatively, if you have any questions regarding your child's progress in Design and Technology or the available GCSE courses, please do not hesitate to contact them via email.

Appointments will be available for parents/carers of students who receive **SEN support to see Mrs Hunt** if required.

The classrooms allocated for Parents Evening will be in B and A block. On arrival to the school, ***please sign in at the B Block entrance (B13)*** and collect a map to help you find your allotted appointments.

I would like to raise with you that several staff and students suffer from Asthma and are highly sensitive to strong fragrances, on occasion resulting in hospitalisation. Therefore, please can I request that ***we all avoid wearing strong fragrances during parents evening in support of the welfare of others.***

Some of the teacher appointments will be in A Block where the classrooms are located on the first floor. Please note that for people who require ***access arrangements there is a lift located at the back of Main Reception*** which leads to the A Block corridor. ***Restrooms will be located near Main Reception.***

Please note that we are expecting many people during parents evening, and alongside other sporting activities taking place around the site after school, this will mean that there is likely to be many cars around the school area. Please therefore can I ask that ***where possible you walk or take public transport to school, or where you need to use a car, that you park a short distance away from the school to help ease with traffic congestion on the evening. Please also allow plenty of time to arrive at school in case of traffic congestion.***
