Dear Parents & Carers

### All Year Groups

We are so proud of the way that all students have adapted to some of the changes that we have implemented this year to create a calmer, more focused, less disrupted and more positive learning experience at school. This combined with the positive feedback we have received regarding the impact of these changes on student punctuality, learning and social interactions has meant we have had a really successful start to the school year to build upon.

Starting from Monday next week we will be making some changes to how Line-Ups work in support of this. Pastoral Morning Line-Ups with tutors will continue as they currently do, with phones handed in at the start of the day (for year's 8-11). Pastoral Afternoon line-ups will now switch to after period 5, with phones returned to students from 3pm onwards at the end of the school day. Line-ups after lunch have been so successful in improving punctuality, that we have decided to get more swiftly into classroom learning by having period 5 teachers meeting students and escorting them to the start of their final lesson of the day. The line ups at the end of the day will also enable us to stagger the students exit safely without having to shorten any lesson time.

All students have been informed today of these changes and will receive further information and support on Monday. As with previous adjustments we are aware that in the very first instance, the change will take more time than current arrangements, however we are confident that, as with morning and current afternoon line ups, they will quickly become part of the routine and habit that enables everyone's focus to be firmly on lessons and learning time being maximised for all.
