PSHE Workshop

We are writing to inform you of an exciting opportunity for your child as part of their PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education) lessons during the week commencing **24th March**. Year 9 students will take part in a workshop aimed at raising awareness about knife crime, street violence, and the consequences of gang crime.

The workshop, titled "*A Cronx Tale*," is an engaging and interactive session that includes a short, animated film followed by a group discussion. This program is designed specifically for 10–16-year-olds to help them understand the dangers and potential life-changing consequences of street violence, gang involvement, and county lines. It encourages students to think critically about the realities of these issues, going beyond the glamorised portrayals and considering the impact on themselves, their families, and their communities.

The workshop will be delivered by **Croydon Drop In** and is completely free of charge. It has been co-designed with input from young people, professionals, and families who have had firsthand experience with gang crime. The session will be conducted in a safe, supportive environment, led by trained and experienced staff who will facilitate the group discussion in an enjoyable yet thought-provoking manner. Your child's usual class teacher will also be present.

There is no further action required from parents or students. Your child simply needs to attend their PSHE lesson as usual during this week. We believe this workshop will provide valuable learning and open important discussions that can contribute to keeping our communities safer.
