- 🛡️ Basics: students attaining 4-9 in both English and Maths = 76%
- 🛡️ Basics: students attaining 5-9 in both English and Maths = 48%
- 🛡️ Average grade per student = 5-
- 🛡️ EBACC = 15%
- 🛡️ Attainment 8 = 4.84



What to do next...

Either:

🛡 Write a letter to the company.

Explain who you are and what you would like to do and give details of why and when.

Or:

🛡 Ring and ask to speak to Manager / HR Department.

Then:

🛡 Take / send WEX Employer form to placement for completion.

🛡 Return completed Student and Employer form by **Monday 2nd DECEMBER 2019**

What happens next

- All placements are contacted/visited and a placement assessment / health and safety check is completed.
(This is why we ask for the forms back at the beginning of December.)
- An agreement is drawn up and sent to employer and parents with details of placement.
(To be signed and returned to WEX team before the start of work experience.)
- Students are visited or receive a phone call by a member of staff during Work Experience.
