Poetry Live! - Friday 29th November 2019

The English Department is delighted to have been able to make a booking for the very popular Poetry Live! Conference, designed for students who are studying the English Literature GCSE course.

There will be live performances from some of Britain's best known contemporary poets, poets will respond to student questions and discuss how poems connect to and influence other poems. In the the examiner sessions Chief Examiners will deal with two skills vital for success in the GCSE English Literature examinations. The first session will look at how students might deal with unseen poems in the exam. The second session will look at comparing poems, whether they are studied poems or unseen, and how to write most effectively in either situation. Pupils who have attended the conference in past years have found the day stimulating and fun. We are keen for pupils to enjoy and have an understanding of a range of poets' work in the lead up to the unseen and anthology poetry questions in the GCSE Literature exams.

The conference is being held at the Apollo Victoria London and will run from 10.45 am to 3.00 pm. We will meet at school at 8.30 am to register, before leaving on the coach at 9.00am. We aim to return to school between 4.30 pm and 5.00 pm. Pupils must bring a packed lunch. The organisers of the conference have requested the students wear school uniform.

We only have limited places available and therefore places will be dealt with on a first come, first served basis. The total cost of the trip including travel and tickets will be £32.00.
