Dear Parent / Carer and Student

I wanted to take this opportunity to introduce myself to you, to express how privileged and proud I feel to be appointed as the future Headteacher of Warlingham School & Sixth Form College and to say how much I am looking forward to working with governors, staff, parents and students to ensure the School motto 'Wide Horizons, High Aspirations' is a reality for every Warlingham student.

I realise that Warlingham is a very good school and it is my aim to continue to deliver and build on the school's great strengths. I have been fortunate to teach and be part of the school leadership in 3 schools most recently as Senior Vice Principal at Hayes school in Bromley where we were able to take the school to Ofsted Outstanding. I would want nothing less for Warlingham and therefore one of our key aims would be working towards achieving this.

This will secure a smooth transition and allow me to begin planning for the next academic year, alongside the Senior Leadership Team. I look forward to using this earlier start as an opportunity to get to know governors, staff, parents and the students so that together, we can begin the work to build on the strengths of the School and identify key objectives for further improvement.
