We are currently planning our provision for the next two weeks to continue to support our families with critical workers. This will be for the period from Monday 18th May 2020 until Friday 29th May 2020. This period includes our half-term holiday period and the Bank Holiday, Monday 25th May.


It is likely that we will continue to provide support from a hub of three of our five schools, Warlingham School, Hamsey Green Primary School and Bletchingley Village Primary School for this period. Families from Woodlea and Tatsfield Primary Schools will continue to be welcomed at either of the Hub Primary schools, please let us know which one would be your preference. Please be assured that children will always see staff they know, even if they are attending a different school because all our staff are now deployed across the three schools remaining open.

Following the recent announcement from the Government, we are now starting to plan for the possible phased return of other year groups, if it is deemed safe to do so from June 1st. These plans are still at a very early stage and we expect more guidance over the coming days. Please be aware that provision for critical workers will continue whether these plans go ahead or not, we will keep you updated as this unfolds.
