As you may or may not be aware, students in year 8 are currently preparing for their Key Assessment Points (KAPS) which will take place from Thursday of this week through to the end of the week after half term. These assessments are due to take place in their normal lessons and should be planned for via Satchel:one, (indicated by a purple assignment in the calendar view). In addition, students will be preparing for these assessments in class time using various Practice 4 Progress techniques shared and used in the past few weeks.

Throughout the year, Year 8 students will experience in class end of unit assessments, regular checking arrival within lessons and a final KAP (Key Assessment Point) week in May 2022 (23<sup>rd</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>).
