## Year 10 Work Experience 2022

We are delighted to announce that Work Experience (WEX) is back! All students in Year 10 will take part in compulsory Work Experience from **Monday 4**<sup>th</sup> **July to Friday 15**<sup>th</sup> **July 2022.** 

We are working in collaboration with Changing Education to provide your child with this exciting opportunity. We believe that work experience plays an important role in a student's careers education and guidance. For some, it's their first introduction to the World of Work and provides an opportunity to showcase and develop their key employability skills. It also enables students to network with potential future employers whilst enhancing students' wellbeing.

During assembly this morning your child has been informed about this event and we have introduced them to the ConnectED app, which will be the main tool to plan and organise their work experience placement. You will find attached to this email a document that outlines how you can support your child to make the best use of this app.

## Key dates for your diary:

- Students to have downloaded the app by: <u>Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021</u> and logged in using their unique QR code which has been emailed to their school email account.
- 2. Students to have found their own placement by Monday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022.

Each student will be expected to arrange their own placement and work the normal working hours of the company or organisation for the duration of the placement, unless prohibited by the constraint of a previously arranged appointment (medical etc) or genuine illness. In these circumstances the students should inform the Employer at the beginning of the placement.

For any students planning to carry out their placement with parents or carers, we have attached a waiver form to this letter which overrides the need for a risk assessment. This will need to be filled out and sent to riskassessment@changingeducation.co.uk.

Once your child has found their own placement, they need to input the placement details into the **'ConnectED'** app. This will allow the school to verify the placement provider so that Changing





Education can begin facilitating the risk assessment process. Students are also encouraged to engage with numerous key pre-placement resources via the app to ready themselves for their placement and reflect upon the development of their skills.
