## Dear Parents \& Carers

We are looking forward to welcoming your child to Warlingham School \& Sixth Form College on Monday $4^{\text {th }}$ September at 8.35am.

We would request that students do not come onto the school premises before 8.25 am and that parents say their goodbyes at the gate. Staff will be available to escort all students to the meeting point for the start of their first day.

The school day will end at 3.10pm when students will be dismissed to make their way home. We would ask that parents do not enter the school premises at the end of the school day to collect their child.

Students will be completing a range of activities during the transition day and these will include, an assembly, tutor time, tour of the school, student photos, finger scanning for wise pay, an enrichment fair and reading and spelling assessments. Students will need to use headphones for the assessments and therefore we would request that you provide your child with their own plug-in headphones to support this.
