Another particularly moving day was spent at Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp, where students reflected maturely on the events of the Holocaust. From the moment they arrived, students showed curiosity, enthusiasm and a real passion for learning, which was commented on by members of the public in Berlin and at the hostel where they stayed. The trip not only deepened their historical understanding but also created lasting memories for students and staff alike, a truly inspiring experience for them all.
