Year 11 Arrangements after Easter

Dear Parents/ Carers

Please see below the arrangements for students when they return to school after the Easter break.

Students will continue with their normal timetabled lessons up until the end of Friday 13th May.

On **Monday 16th May** we will begin a 2-week Special timetable, where there will be a mixture of booster sessions, exams, study rooms in school and home study up until **Friday 27th May** (half-term).

From Monday 6th June until Thursday 23rd June when exams finish there will be a dual offer. Students needing support or help can continue to attend school in the normal way. During this time we will have study rooms available for students to revise and prepare for upcoming exams. Students may also utilise home study if they prefer and just attend booster sessions and exams.

Explanation of Terms

Booster Session

This is a short session, before the exam, to prepare for the exam students are about to sit. Staff will remind students of timings, exam techniques for the paper they are taking, key words and structure. There may be time to revisit key themes / formulas / brainstorm key words.

Study Rooms

These are timetabled, staffed rooms where Year 11 students can come to complete silent study / revision and seek help with upcoming exams or areas of study they are unsure of.

Home study

This is time for students to prepare for exams at home. Students must ensure they leave sufficient time to arrive at school in plenty of time for Exam boosters and Exams.
