





#### **Assessment Content**

- Reports in KS3 will include attitude to learning data on behaviour, classwork and homework. They will be judged as being excellent, good, requires improvement or unacceptable.
- The report will also include curriculum statements. Each topic students are working on are assessed and are judged as either mastered, secured, developing or emerging.



#### **Assessment Content**

- For the Mid KS3 and End of KS3 exams, students are assessed on a wider range of topics in each subject. This provides the first stepping stones towards a GCSE exam experience.
- Results from these exams will be shared with parents and students, alongside the curriculum and attitude to learning statements.




