Cern



Our most recent school trip took place last week, where eight Year 12 physics students and two staff travelled to Geneva for an exciting visit to **Cern**. After arriving in Switzerland, the group first visited the **Swiss Plasma Centre**, where students learned about research into nuclear fusion as a future energy source. The group stayed overnight at Geneva Youth Hostel before visiting CERN the following day. Highlights included the **Antimatter Factory** and learning about the **Linac particle accelerator**, which feeds the **Large Hadron Collider**.



After the visit, students explored Geneva, seeing the **Jet d'Eau** and crossing **Lake Geneva** by boat. The trip was a memorable experience that brought classroom physics to life.
