Year 9 Options Process

We are delighted to begin the exciting journey of supporting our Year 9 students as they select the courses they wish to study in Years 10 and 11. This is a significant milestone in their educational journey, and we are committed to ensuring that students feel well-informed and supported throughout the process.

On Thursday next week, students will attend their first introductory assembly, during which we will outline the timeline, explain the steps involved in making their choices, and introduce some of the new subjects they may wish to consider for their Key Stage 4 studies. This marks the start of a carefully designed programme to guide them in making informed decisions.

Wednesday 11th February – Year 9 Options Fair: This event provides an opportunity to speak with Heads of Department about their subjects in greater depth and ask any questions that may help in making informed choices.

Monday 15th March – Options Submission Deadline: All options choices must be submitted by this date. Further details regarding the submission process will follow.

As outlined in the booklet, students will have access to a great deal of careers support and guidance throughout the options process. This includes access to resources, tailored advice, and opportunities to discuss their aspirations and interests with staff.
