



Dear Parents/Carers

Firstly, I hope the students, yourselves and your families have had a lovely and relaxing summer break. We are really looking forward to welcoming all Year 7 students on Monday 5th September at 8.35am to start the new academic year. In order to maintain our high presentation and behaviour expectations and to begin the year in a positive way, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the school uniform policy.

Whilst the vast majority of students have the correct uniform and wear is smartly and with pride, we would like to remind students that when they arrive at school, they are expected to be wearing full school uniform.

Skirts will need to be at a suitable length, blazer sleeves must not be rolled up and all jewellery should be in keeping with the school uniform policy. We would like to take this opportunity to inform you that false eyelashes, false nails and nail varnish must not be worn at school. 1 set of ear studs are permitted, however smart watches, air pods, rings, bracelets, nose piercings and necklaces are not permitted under any circumstances.

Mobile phones must be switched off before entering the school grounds and must not be switched on until students have left the school buildings at the end of the school day.

### Year 7

- Navy blue blazer with school badge
- Optional navy-blue V-necked pullover with school badge
- Navy blue A Line skirt with inverted pleat - SKIRT LENGTHS MUST BE NO MORE THAN 15CM ABOVE THE KNEE. NO OTHER SKIRTS SHOULD BE WORN
- Tailored school trousers in grey, charcoal, or black
- Students currently wearing navy trousers can continue to do so until July 2023
- Leggings, tight fitted and ankle length trousers are not permitted
- Plain white buttoned shirt with collar (both long and short sleeved shirts are permitted)
- Revere collared blouses can be worn by students in Years 8-11 until July 2023
- House coloured tie
- Plain white, navy or black socks
- Plain black or nude coloured tights (patterned tights are not permitted). Socks and tights should not be worn together
- Socks should not be worn above the knee
- Plain black sensible leather shoes (no logo), maximum 3cm inner edge of heel, no boots, no canvas shoes, no trainer style shoes

Students must also make sure they have a suitable bag to carry multiple A4 sized books and bring the required kit on PE days.

Please remember to bring along a set of plug-in headphones for use on the first day, along with essential pencil case equipment, including pens, one blue/black and green and highlighters. Pencil, sharpener and coloured pencils, glue stick, ruler, rubber, calculator (Casio) FX-83-85 & mathematical set.

Please bring a packed lunch or some money for lunch (suggest £3.50) until Wisepay is set up.
