## **GCSE PE Practical Moderation Dates**

I am writing to inform you about your son/daughter's internal PE practical moderations this year. A requirement of the course is that each student completes three practically assessed performances and the three grades will count towards their final GCSE PE grade.

## **Practical Performance**

Your son/daughter will be internally assessed in **three or more** practical activities. They will be assessed by a member of the PE department internal, using the assessment criteria for their sport. They will be assessed on the following: range of skills, quality of skills, physical attributes and decision making. If your son/daughter is unaware of the skills they need to demonstrate, they should ask their PE teacher or go to Satchel One where the specification has been uploaded. Please ensure your son/daughter is fully prepared for their moderations and that they turn up in **full school kit** for their sports (e.g. shin pads for football).

## **Practical Moderation Dates:**

- Tuesday 22nd June = Football Moderation (STp / CHt)
- Wednesday 23rd June = Netball Moderation (PHu / HRa)
- Thursday 24th June = Tennis (STp)
- Thursday 24th June = Table Tennis Moderation (CHt / DGu)
- Wednesday 30th June = Dance Moderation (STp / CHt / HRa)
- Thursday 1st July = Gymnastics (STp/PHu)
- Wednesday 7th July = Cricket Moderation (RSo / STp)
- Thursday 15th July = Swimming Moderation (STp / CHt)
- Athletics Moderation = Tuesday 29th June (STp / CHt / PHu) + Tuesday 6th July (STp / CHt / HRa) + Tuesday 13th July (STp / CHt / HRa / PHu) – students will be made aware of which dates they need to attend.
- Rugby = TBC (September)
- Trampolining = TBC (September)
- Basketball = TBC (September)
- Equestrian = Filmed footage required

Please note that these are final assessments and will count towards your son/daughter's overall GCSE PE grade. Failure to attend an assessment will result in them receiving zero. If students would also like to submit film footage, please send in any footage and we can use this to help moderate them.
